Option #1 Cloud of Witnesses

Summary: *“Remember your leaders, those who spoke to you the word of God. Consider the outcome of their way of life, and imitate their faith” Hebrews 13:7*

The Bible is full of great examples of lives lived in faith but the story of God’s work through mankind did not stop with the acts of the Apostles. In this class we will look at the lives of those who exemplified faith throughout church history and learn from their example as we consider what God might have for us in our time.

Option #2 Honour Thy Father and Thy Mother

Summary: The fifth command - you know the one, to honour parents, is not always an easy one for children to follow. Thankfully, it doesn’t apply to adults...or does it? What could it mean for us as adults? We’ll look at the Biblical understanding of honour, answering some common questions and misconceptions surrounding the command as well as what it looks like for children, of all stages and ages, today. We’ll also hear from some people who have had to learn how to do this in their own situation; inspiring us to move from the ‘forgotten commandment’ to the ‘remembered commandment’.
